LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

Here are a few tips when asking someone to write a recommendation on your behalf. Generally, you'll want to choose someone (teacher, coach, and/or club sponsor) who knows you well, has a positive opinion of you, and can highlight your strengths.

- WHO: Choose recommenders who know you well and are likely to write a strong recommendation for you.
- **PROVIDE:** Give the recommender your unofficial transcript, completed questionnaire and your academic resume. The more information you can provide, the stronger the recommendation will be.
- **DUE DATES:** Give your recommender at least TWO WEEKS to compile a letter. Agree upon a due date and mark your calendar to set reminders and follow up with your recommender.
- **APPROACH:** Be sure to *ASK* if a letter can be written, say PLEASE and THANK YOU. Teachers, counselors, coaches, etc. all have the right to decline your request.
- AFTER: Once your letter is written, don't forget to thank your recommender for the letter they provided. Make sure you obtain a PDF of the letter.
