

Lee's Summit North IB Access/Admission Policy

At Lee's Summit North, there is no set admission policy that serves as a gatekeeper allowing students in an IB course, Diploma Program, or Career-related Program. Instead, all students are encouraged to participate in any segment of IB that fits each student's individual needs. There is no set GPA, teacher recommendation, etc.

During the spring semester, students begin the enrollment process. Our counselors begin the process by visiting classrooms reviewing the enrollment process, graduation requires, and career pathways. Concurrent with these visits, the students meet individually with their mentoring teachers reviewing all the courses and programs we offer; of course, the IB is discussed as an option.

In addition to the counselors and mentors, the IB Coordinator visits EVERY sophomore history or English class discuss the IB program. Students are given a brochure outlining all our programs. During the presentation, student questions are answered. After the presentation, students are encouraged to meet the IB Coordinator individually to further discuss the IB program.

A week prior to the student enrolling, we host a day "enrollment fair" where students choose five different course-offering presentations. IB has two separate presentations. One is given by the IB coordinator discussing all aspects of the program. The second IB specific presentation is given by our elective IB teachers for courses that do not have a specific precursor course. For instance, IB History has precursor courses, Advanced Studies World History and World History. Those specific history teachers discuss the history options for sophomores during class. A course that has no specific precursor would be IB Psychology, IB Social and Cultural Anthropology, IB Business Administration, and IB Sports, Exercise, and Health Science.

After the schedules are done, the IB Coordinator targets current sophomore students who have enrolled in three HL courses and not indicated becoming a Diploma Candidate. The coordinator sends individual invitations to these students seeing if they have an interest in becoming a Diploma Candidate.

Our school pays the fees for all DP and CP candidates. In addition, our school pays the fees for all our Free/Reduced lunch students. Course students who are still in need can asked for financial assistance.
