A: Focus and method

4While clearly an issue of contemporary global significance, little is done to set the question in this context. Rather, the student focuses the question on a local issue while using local research methods to provide evidence for her claims. The topic is communicated clearly, and the research method is clearly stated and focused. The methodology is generally relevant and original, and there is evidence that the selection was informed. The essay is interdisciplinary in nature, but the student has not explained why such an approach is necessary.

B: Knowledge and understanding

4While knowledge and understanding of the topic is demonstrated, there is a reliance on one methodology, which the student acknowledges is limiting. While history is nominated as one of the subjects, there is little use of historical terminology, making it challenging to show knowledge and understanding.

C: Critical thinking

9A reasoned argument is developed from the research, and the analysis is generally good. While the argument is generally structured, there are minor inconsistencies that hinder its strength.

D: Presentation

3Presentation is good. The structure and layout of the essay is appropriate and follows the expected format for academic writing.

E: Engagement

5There is clearly a high level of intellectual engagement as the student's reflections show significant initiative in their choice of topic and research. However, there is little discussion of why the methodology was chosen or why changes were made in the research process.Total marks awarded25/34
